

ATTENTION MEMBERS!!!

Credit union members have been receiving E-mails from someone impersonating the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA), asking for information. **This is a scam.** Someone is fraudulently using the NCUA's logo to Phish for information.

Phishing is the act of sending an E-mail to a user falsely claiming to be an established, legitimate enterprise in an attempt to scam the user into surrendering private information that will be used for identity theft.

The E-mail directs the user to visit a web site where they are asked to update personal information, such as passwords, credit card numbers, social security numbers, and bank account numbers, that the legitimate company already has. The web site however, is bogus and set up only to steal the user's information.

If you receive any E-mails inquiring about your PAFCU accounts, passwords, card numbers, or any information regarding the credit union, **DO NOT RESPOND. Contact People's Alliance Federal Credit Union ASAP. People's Alliance does not under any circumstances solicit information via the internet.**
